## Standards Drafting Updates

### **SAR-001-TRE-02 – The Provision for the ERCOT ISO to Participate and Have a 1/4 Vote in the Processes**

The ERCOT Board approved the Provision to give ERCOT 1/4 vote at their meeting on February 17<sup>th</sup>. The approved documents to implement this provision have been submitted to NERC for approval.

### **SAR-002-TRE-01 – Underfrequency Load Shedding**

The NERC UFLS Standard Drafting Team (SDT) is working to finish its work and post a draft of a standard for a second round of comments in 4-6 weeks. The team's current work can be found at: Given the proposed NERC schedule, the regional UFLS SDT will reconvene in mid to late May.

### **SAR-003-TRE-01 – FERC-Ordered Modification to ERCOT CPS2 Waiver to R2 of BAL-001-0**

The draft standard BAL-001-TRE-01 was accepted by the RSC at the March 4<sup>th</sup> meeting to post for public comment. The draft standard and all supporting documents have been posted on the Texas RE Reliability Standards Tracking site and a 30-day comment period opened on March 16<sup>th</sup> and will close April 14<sup>th</sup>. **[View the Reliability Standards Tracking site.](#)**

### **Schedule for 2009 NERC Self-Certification Submissions**

The following is the Texas Regional Entity's (Texas RE) schedule for the 2009 NERC Self Certification process for portal submission/posting:

**June 1<sup>st</sup>** - Texas RE will post the Self-Certifications for GO, GOP

**July 1<sup>st</sup>** - Self-Certifications for GO, GOP are DUE

**August 3<sup>rd</sup>** – Texas RE will post the Self-Certifications for TO, TP, DP, PSE, LSE

**September 3<sup>rd</sup>** - Self-Certifications for TO, TP, DP, PSE, LSE are DUE

All entities will have 30 days to submit their completed Self-Certification forms on the portal.
