Control Performance Highlights

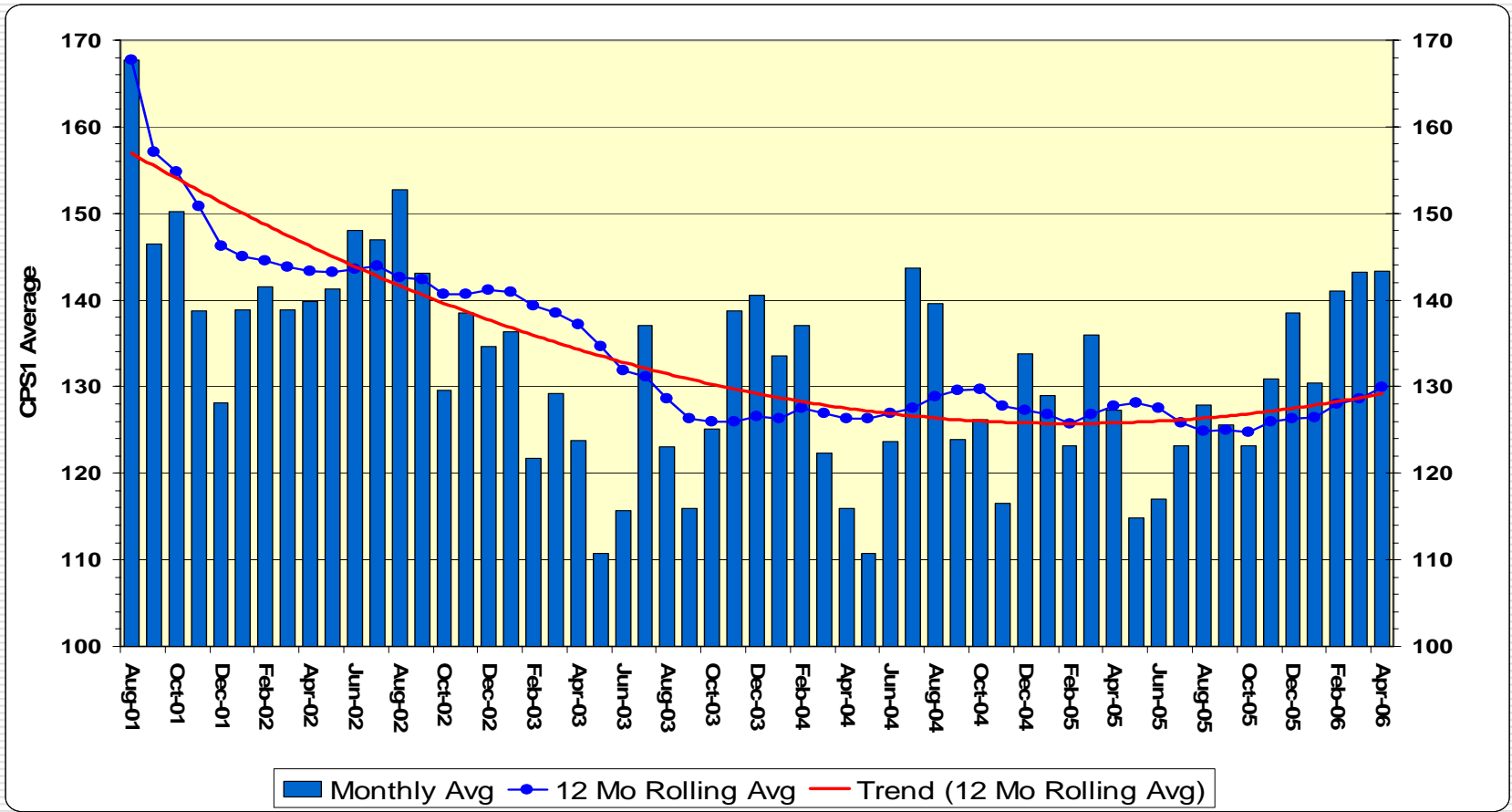
□ NERC CPS1 Performance

- ERCOT's April score was 143.31
- April 17th daily score was 36; April score excluding the 17th was 147.01
- March thru June have typically been ERCOT's poorest performing months in last 3 years

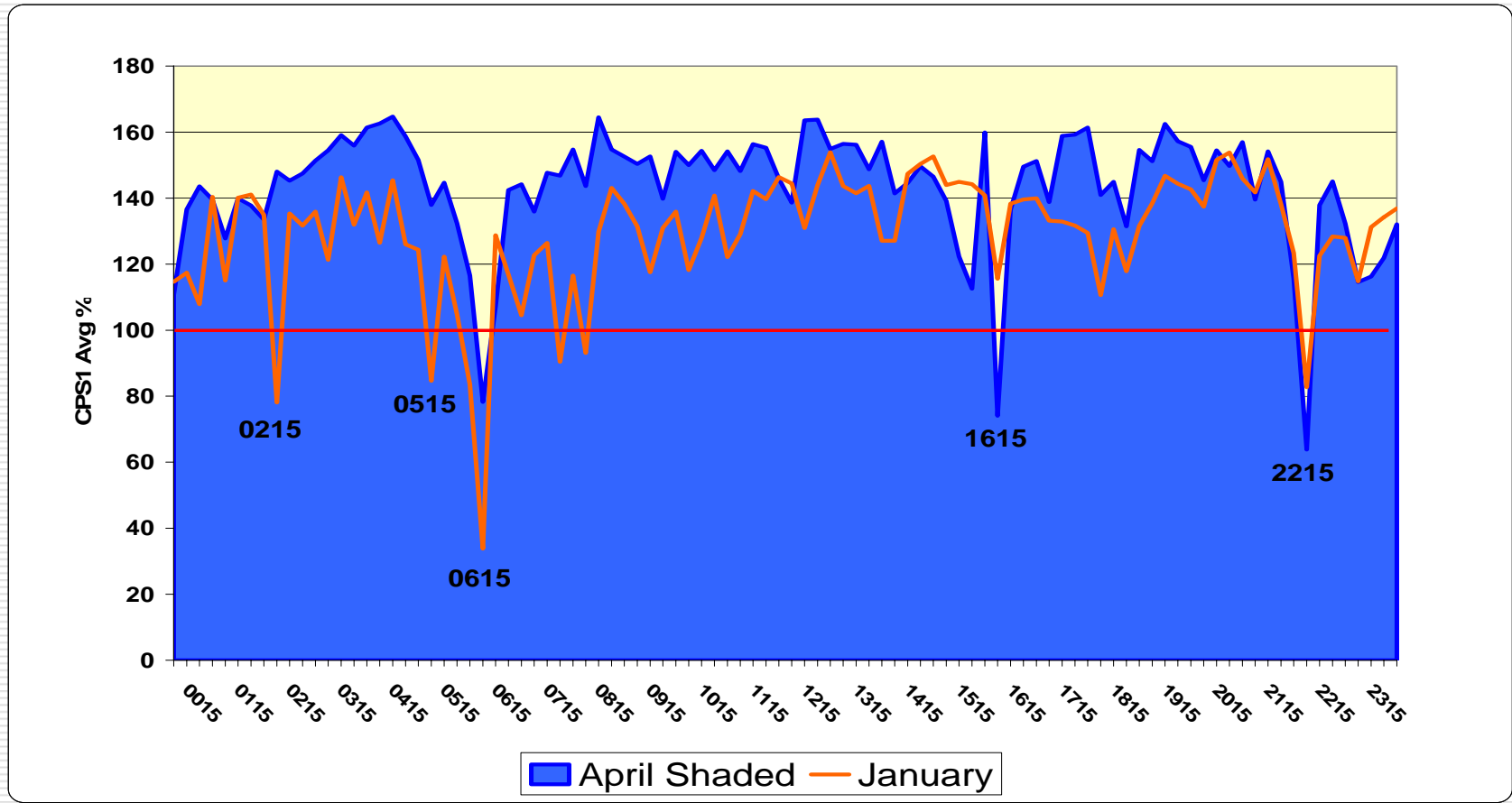
□ PRR 525 Performance

- 26 passed / 5 non-wind-only QSEs failed the measure in March
 - 25 passed / 7 non-wind-only QSEs failed the measure in April (preliminary)
 - Scores posted on the ERCOT Compliance Web Page
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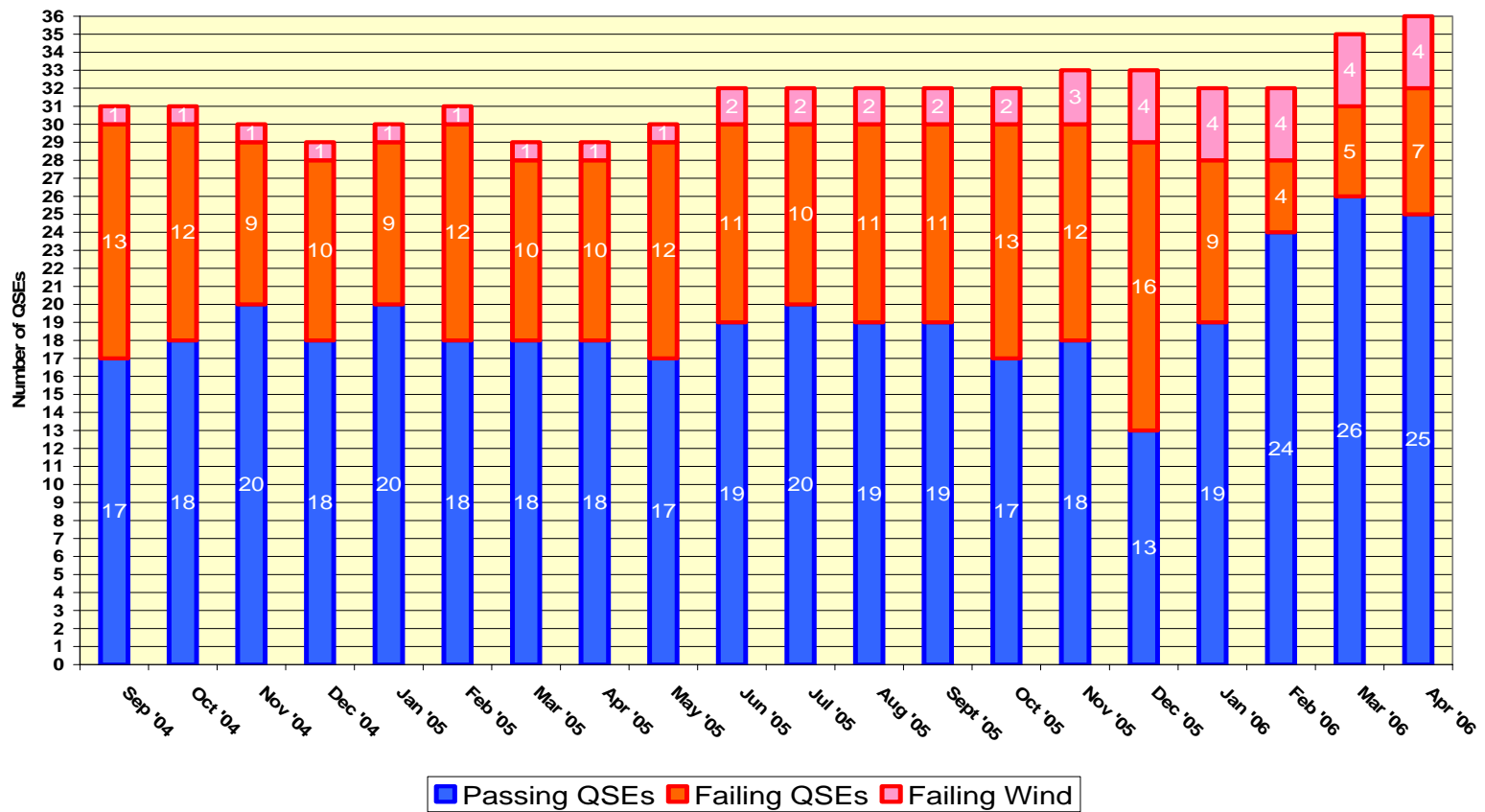
ERCOT's CPS1 Monthly Trend



ERCOT CPS1 by Interval



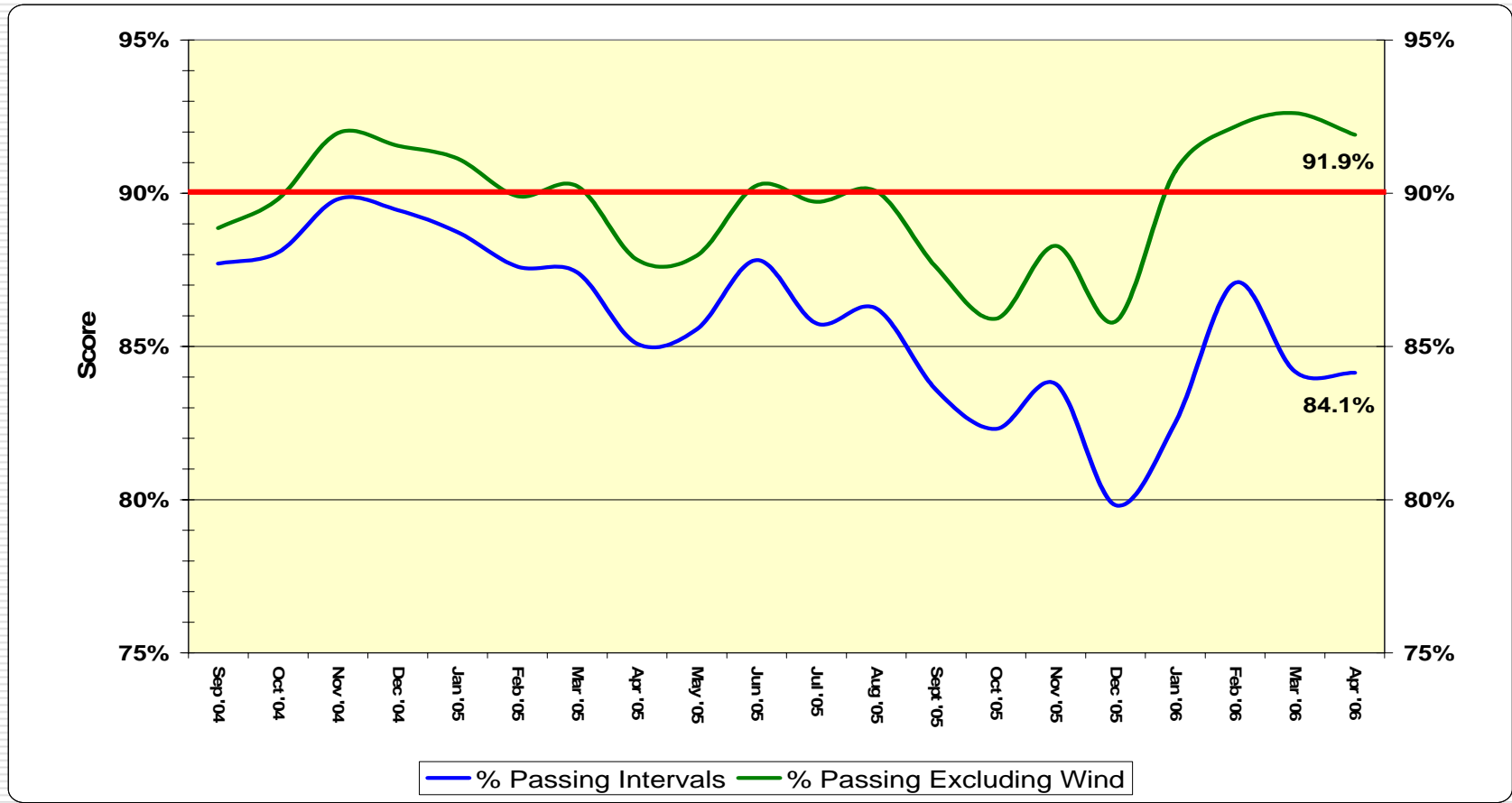
QSE PRR525 10-Minute Interval Scoring

ERCOT Compliance Process

□ Current Timeline

- May 12th – ERCOT files new redline
 - May 22nd – Replies to ERCOT redline (include redlines if any)
 - May 31st – Workshop to review all redlines and get consensus on most or all of document – all day if necessary
 - June 6th – ERCOT files revisions
 - June 13th – Deadline for filing hearing request
 - June 27th – Pre-hearing conference if necessary
