SYSTEM PROTECTION WORKING GROUP
REPORT TO ROS
OCTOBER 12, 2006

The last meeting of the ERCOT System Protection Working Group was held in Corpus Christi on July 27-28, 2006. Of significance to ROS are the following items:

Short Circuit Data Cases: As of this time ERCOT has finished processing and has posted the future years cases (2007-2010).

Operationally Significant 138 kV Elements: Shortly before the last ROS meeting, ERCOT sent the list of these elements to the working group members. The group is now working on verifying these elements.

Relay Disturbance Issues: As of this time we have been asked to review the Austin Energy disturbance of June 12 once AE sends us a final report on that outage.

Relay Maintenance Requirements: The relay maintenance sub-group working on this reported to the working group. A proposal for a battery maintenance section of the Operating Guides will be forthcoming through an OGRR.

Next Meeting: The next meeting will be held in Waco on November 16-17.
