SYSTEM PROTECTION WORKING GROUP
REPORT TO ROS
FEBRUARY 15, 2007

The last meeting of the ERCOT System Protection Working Group was held in Waco on November 16-17, 2006. Of significance to ROS are the following items:

Short Circuit Data Cases: The 2007 case has been submitted to ERCOT. They are presently reviewing first draft changes.

Operating Guide Section 7 and SPWG Procedure Revisions: Various changes were discussed by the SPWG for both documents. The draft for changes will be submitted to the group for approval, and then the OG revisions will be submitted in the form of an OGRR, and the procedures will be submitted to ROS for approval.

Relay Maintenance Requirements: The relay maintenance sub-group working on this reported to the working group. A proposal for a battery maintenance section of the Operating Guides will be forthcoming through an OGRR.

New Chair and Vice-Chair: The SPWG approved by email vote that Stan Ginsburg remain as Chair for 2007. Mark Chronister, who had previously been voted as Vice Chair, agreed to retain that position.

Next Meeting: The next meeting will be held in Austin in February 22-23, 2007.
