SYSTEM PROTECTION WORKING GROUP
REPORT TO ROS
March 15-16, 2007

The last meeting of the ERCOT System Protection Working Group was held in Austin on February 22-23, 2007. Of significance to ROS are the following items:

Short Circuit Data Cases: The 2007 year case is in progress. The present pass is due back to ERCOT March 15.

ERCOT Staffing: It was announced that our ERCOT data support representative Jose Gaytan will be replaced later in the year. This was a bit of a surprise since he has only been assigned to our Working Group less than a year and also in light of the problems we had last year in working without data support for a few months. Jose is doing an excellent job for our group, and we are hoping his replacement will be as competent as he is.

Operating Guide Section 7: Various changes were discussed by the SPWG for Section 7 at our November meeting. Some additional changes were suggested at this meeting. An OGRR has been submitted for the changes.

Data Distribution: System maps and single line diagrams were exchanged between members.

Relay Misoperations Report: This report will be due by June 1 for data collected over the past reporting period.

Relay Disturbance Issues: ERCOT compliance discussed an EECF event from last December.

Next Meeting: The next scheduled Working Group meeting will be held in Fort Worth in July, 2007.
