SYSTEM PROTECTION WORKING GROUP
REPORT TO ROS
May 10, 2007

The last meeting of the ERCOT System Protection Working Group was held in Austin on February 22-23, 2007. Of significance to this ROS meeting are the following items:

Short Circuit Data Cases: The 2007 year case has been completed. The first pass of the Future Years Cases are presently at ERCOT and are due back to the members shortly.

Relay Misoperations Report: This report will be due by June 1 for data collected over the past reporting period.

Low Voltage Ride Through (LVRT): It was learned during the past few weeks that our working group had been assigned the task of developing initial working guide language concerning this NERC requirement. This assignment was in accordance with the February ROS meeting minutes. Although more of a stability issue rather than a protection issue, our group will discuss this at our July meeting and attempt to develop the draft.

Further, it is recommended to ROS that special projects or assignments such as these be assigned only by email from the ROS Chair to the Working Group chairs, rather than by reading the meeting minutes or by some other means.

Next Meeting: The next scheduled Working Group meeting will be held in Fort Worth in July, 2007.
