SYSTEM PROTECTION WORKING GROUP
REPORT TO ROS
December 6, 2007

The last meeting of the ERCOT System Protection Working Group was held in Nursery, Texas on November 8-9, 2007. Of significance to this ROS meeting are the following items:

Short Circuit Data Cases: A schedule for 2008 was made with the aid of Doug Evans from ERCOT. The schedule fell apart this year when a number of members were late on submitting data. In the future, all members not following the schedule will be referred to TRE for action.

Discussion and Recommendation of Low Voltage Ride Through (LVRT)

Our group is working on wording based on Appendix G of the document for the groups review. After lengthy discussion, it was decided that the wording will be completed at the February meeting.

NERC DAWG Report

As part of our WG procedures it has been our duty to review the NERC DAWG report on a yearly basis and make recommendations to ROS items that may prevent outages and/or enhance system protection. The format of the public report published by NERC over the past few years has changed to a point where this document is no longer a valuable document to review. In the future, this item may be dropped from our procedures, with ROS approval.

Discussion of Black Start Training Relay Requests

ERCOT System Operations has requested that our members provide data on certain relays to be used in their Black Start training program. After discussion, members will provide that data directly to this group by the end of February.

Election of New Officers **(Requires ROS Vote)**

Mark Chronister of Oncor was elected Chair and Glenn Hargraves of CPS Energy was elected Vice-Chair for 2008.
