

# LSE File Definition

## 1 File Naming Convention

The recommended file naming convention is <DUNS><ReportName><DateTime><Counter> .lse < optional data> in addition to any application file naming conventions used in transmitting the file. For example, "999999999IntervalData20081227113001123 .lse < optional data>" where:

Element	Explanation	Format
DUNS	TDSP DUNS Number	Numeric (9 or 13)
ReportName	'IntervalData'	Alphanumeric (12)
DateTime	File transmission date/time stamp	Datetime format = ccymmddhhmmss
Counter	Counter with no specified value	Numeric (3)
.lse	Value of .lse in file name	
< optional data >	Any optional data, if necessary	Cannot contain csv

At a minimum the filename must contain .lse after decryption otherwise the file will be rejected by ERCOT. The filename cannot contain csv after decryption. Files will be sent with a NAESB input-format of "FF"
