Issue:

Confirmation of Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Chair and Vice Chair.

Background/History:

Section 5.1(e) of the Amended and Restated Bylaws of Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT), approved on September 17, 2007 (Bylaws), requires that the ERCOT Board of Directors (Board) confirm the Chair and Vice Chair of TAC each year. At the January 8, 2009 TAC meeting, the TAC representatives elected Mark Bruce of FPL Energy LLC and Shannon McClendon, the TAC Residential Consumer Representative as Chair and Vice Chair, respectively.

Key Factors Influencing Issue:

The ERCOT Bylaws require Board confirmation of the TAC Chair and Vice Chair.

Alternatives:

Refrain from confirming the TAC Chair and Vice Chair and require TAC to elect a new chair and Vice Chair.

Conclusion/Recommendation:

Confirm Mark Bruce as TAC Chair and Shannon McClendon as TAC Vice Chair.
