- Merged System Planning and Operations
  - Eliminated VP, Planning position
- Centralized Compliance
- Eliminated CRR Manager position
- Minimized our Zonal operations functions to support Nodal Project

### Current Organization Trip Doggett

2009 Budget ≈ \$33.9M

System Planning & Operations – Kent Saathoff, VP

- 196 employees
- ≈51% of my 2009 budget

Markets - Betty Day, Director

- 110 employees
- ≈25% of my 2009 budget

Client Services – Dale Goodman, Director

- 44 employees
- ≈13% of my 2009 budget

Compliance - Chuck Manning, VP

- 28 employees
- ≈11% of my 2009 budget

- Since 2006 ERCOT has grown by 163 employees, 75 in my area
- Compliance Department: +15
- Nodal Functions

- Day Ahead Market	+10
- CRR	+ 5

- Real Time	+ 6
- Settlement & Billing	+ 6
- Client Services	+ 7
- Metering	+ 1

Study Horsepower and Wind Integration

#### Nodal Support Trip Doggett

- 112 FTEs in Nodal Budget
- Internal Employee Rate < ½ of Contractor Rate</li>
- Saving Nodal budget > \$10M/year
- Those who will operate Nodal are building Nodal

### Recent Budget Reductions Trip Doggett

To date, beyond the global reductions mentioned by Bob, we have identified cuts > \$1.6M in 2009:

- Did not fill budgeted positions
- Reduced budget for travel, training and expenses
- Reduced Outside services

### **Examples of Potential Budget Reductions**Trip Doggett

#### Management Recommendations

- Do not fill vacant Project Manager positions
- Reduce Business staff testing IT changes

#### **Moderate Reductions**

- Decreased participation in stakeholder meetings by ERCOT SMEs
- Further reduction of Business staff testing IT changes
- Eliminate ERCOT training of MPs
- Outsource Project Managers and Business Analysts
- Eliminate Demand Response SME
- Eliminate ERCOT Meeting Managers

#### Flat Revenue

- No resources to work on future market design issues, PRR development
- Do not fill Compliance positions
- Reduce Outage Schedulers, Eliminate Operating Engineers on shift
