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
ERCOT Board of Directors Meeting February 16, 2010



- A strong cold front moved southward from the Texas Panhandle into the Sweetwater region.
- The cold front became temporarily stationary in the Sweetwater region from just after 3:00 am until 12:00 pm.
- A low pressure developed along the front in the McCamey region during this period.
- Wind forecast tool did not forecast well

Main Points

• This was not an emergency event

- Never got below 2,500 MW Responsive Reserves
- Did not violate frequency control standards

• Showed some limitations of current operational tools

- 15 minute balancing market requires predictions 30 minutes in advance
- Have to compensate with fleet OOME instructions

Improvements coming

- Implementation and improvement of wind ramp-rate forecasting tool (current and ongoing)
- Implementation of 5 minute Security Constrained Economic Dispatch (SCED) and SCED on demand for market solution (December 1, 2010)
- Review of Ancillary Service requirements for increasing wind (ongoing)
