SAR-003 Regional Standard BAL-001-TRE Real Power Balancing Control Performance

- Comment period on second draft closed March 13.
- The team met on March 18 and April 14 to review comments received and discuss next steps.
- The team anticipates re-drafting the standard in light of the comments received and the FERC Orders from March.
- The next draft will be posted for comments when it is completed.



Proposed SAR-008 – CIP-001-TRE-1 Sabotage Reporting

- This Proposed Regional Variance applies the CIP-001 - Sabotage Reporting – Requirements to TO and GO.
 - Intended to address issues remaining after completion of the LSE Registration and TOP JRO projects until NERC standard revision is completed (NERC Project 2009-01).
- At its April 7 meeting, the RSC members questioned the need for the proposed CIP-001 Regional Variance.
 - Stakeholders questioned whether a reliability gap actually exists, whether the GO function needs to be included, and suggested that TO coverage could be addressed through other means.
 - RSC did not vote at this time.
 - This regional variance may be reconsidered at a future meeting.
