Upcoming Interim Legislative Hearings

- The Senate Natural Resources Committee will hold a hearing on August 18 at which ERCOT has been asked to testify on generation adequacy and transmission and generation planning.
- Chairman Fraser's committee (Senate Natural Resources) is responsible for the following interim charges going forward: a review of the implementation of the EPA's rules on carbon dioxide and potential federal legislation on greenhouse gases; studying whether TCEQ should identify and evaluate cumulative effects of pollutants on public health and the environment; monitoring implementation of air quality legislation.
