- The Existing/New Capacity information located in ERCOT'S 2009 Annual Report on the Texas Renewable Energy Credit Trading Program:
  - represents the total capacity of <u>all</u> generating units <u>registered</u> in the REC Program.
    - The REC Program tracks renewable generation in Texas, including ERCOT and all other regions of Texas.
    - The program is voluntary for generators and tracks only the generation that is registered in the program;
    - therefore, the megawatts of capacity in this report may not align with the total Renewable Resource generation registered in ERCOT System Planning reports or other reporting agencies.
