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# What does the Existing/New Capacity Report represent?

- **The Existing/New Capacity information located in ERCOT'S 2009 Annual Report on the Texas Renewable Energy Credit Trading Program:**
  - represents the total capacity of all generating units registered in the REC Program.
    - *The REC Program tracks renewable generation in Texas, including ERCOT and all other regions of Texas.*
    - *The program is voluntary for generators and tracks only the generation that is registered in the program;*
    - *therefore, the megawatts of capacity in this report may not align with the total Renewable Resource generation registered in ERCOT System Planning reports or other reporting agencies.*
