

Sharyland Transition Taskforce:

The workbook entitled “Reliant Proposed Sharyland Transition Calendar” contains two tabs: the original transition calendar proposed by Sharyland, and Reliant’s proposed amendments to that calendar. The changes we propose were influenced by the following criteria outlined in the [Order](#) approving the transition to competition but summarized as:

- If possible, there should not be a deadline or moratorium on the customer’s ability to select a REP.
- Customers should be able to switch from a Default REP at any time.
- Customers assigned to a default REP should receive a fulfillment package including (a) the date the Default REP began or will begin serving the customer; (b) a contact number for the Default REP; (c) a description of the Default REP’s rate for service; (d) the deposit requirements of the Default REP; and (v) the applicable Terms of Service and Electricity Facts Label (EFL) within 30 days of the ESI ID assignment.
- Customers should receive the notice prior to the transition to competition.

Key changes to the Calendar include:

- Eliminating the proposed moratorium on customer choice.
- Moving the ESI ID assignment period from April to March to allow sufficient time for default REPs to process MVIs and deliver the fulfillment package described above prior to the transition start date.
- Deleting language that would place a moratorium on: out of cycle meter reads, MVIs, and switches during the transition period.

To help with the stacking logic it may be helpful to establish the following criteria:

- Competitive Retailer (CR) MVI trumps Default Provider (DP)
- First CR MVI wins

There may be some issues with this proposal, for example how does the market distinguish between a competitive offer MVI sent from a REP that is also a default provider? Additionally, if a CR submits a MVI in March/April – does that MVI need to occur on-cycle?
