Issue:

Ratification of Chief Compliance Officer as an Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT) Officer.

Background/History:

Section 8.2 of ERCOT’s Amended and Restated Bylaws, as approved on September 5, 2014 (Bylaws), requires that the ERCOT Board of Directors (Board) ratify ERCOT Officers for terms not to exceed one year. Section 8.2 further provides that officers may be re-elected or re-ratified for consecutive terms without limitation and that all officers shall hold office until their successors are chosen and qualified or until their earlier resignation or removal.

On June 2, 2015, Chuck Manning retired from ERCOT as Chief Compliance Officer and Executive Officer. Given ERCOT’s corporate purpose and role in electric reliability, ERCOT management believed it would be best to continue to have a Chief Compliance Officer on staff. Upon his retirement, Mr. Manning’s responsibilities as Chief Compliance Officer were transferred to Betty Day, an ERCOT officer who then held the title of Vice President of Governance, Risk and Compliance. Ms. Day’s current title is now Vice President of Governance, Risk & Compliance and Chief Compliance Officer.

At its meeting on August 10, 2015, the HR&G Committee is expected to consider the ratification of Betty Day as an ERCOT Officer with the additional title of Chief Compliance Officer, that is, as Vice President of Governance, Risk & Compliance and Chief Compliance Officer, effective as of June 2, 2015, as recommended by H.B. “Trip” Doggett, ERCOT President and CEO.

Key Factors Influencing Issue:

- The Bylaws require the ratification of Officers at least annually.
- ERCOT must have a CEO and other Officers to perform its statutory and corporate functions.

Conclusion/Recommendation:

The HR&G Committee will consider recommending whether, at its August 11, 2015 Board meeting, the ERCOT Board should ratify Betty Day as an ERCOT Officer with the title of Vice President of Governance, Risk & Compliance and Chief Compliance Officer, effective as of June 2, 2015, as recommended by Mr. Doggett, ERCOT President and CEO.
