CEO Update: Variance to Budget (\$ in Millions) Net Revenues After Department Expenditures

Net Revenues Year to Date Actuals: \$7.5 M Favorable (as of August 31, 2016)

Major Revenue Variances

\$1.0 M under budget: system administration fees unfavorable due to milder-than-expected weather

Major Expenditure Variances

- \$2.7 M under budget: resource management (\$2.0 M staffing management; \$1.1 M project work; \$ -0.4 M staff backfill)
- \$1.2 M under budget: computer hardware and other equipment purchases
- \$0.9 M under budget: interest expense due to project funding; interest income due to higher rates
- \$1.3 M under budget: employee health, relocation, immigration and recognition program costs
- \$1.7 M under budget: timing differences

Net Revenues Year End Forecast: \$9.6 M Favorable (as of September 29, 2016)

Major Revenue Variances

\$0.8 M over budget: system administration fees favorable based on current actuals and load forecast for remainder of year

Major Expenditure Variances

- \$4.0 M under budget: resource management (\$3.2 M staffing management; \$1.4 M project work; \$ -0.6 M staff backfill)
- \$1.5 M under budget: computer hardware and other equipment purchases
- \$1.4 M under budget: interest expense due to project funding and no revolver usage; interest income due to higher rates
- \$1.2 M under budget: employee health, relocation, immigration and recognition program costs




2016 Off-Cycle & R5 Release Summary

- Outage Scheduler Enhancements Go Live September 26, 2016
- R5 Release Dates: November 1 − 3, 2016
- Includes changes for Daylight Savings Time (DST)
- 106 Change Requests across the application areas
- NPRRs and SCRs
 - NOGRR143: Alignment of Nodal Operating Guides with NERC Reliability Standard, BAL-001-TRE-1
 - NPRR495: Changes to Ancillary Services Capacity Monitor
 - NPRR712: Clarification of RUC Process
 - NPRR736: Updates to the Ancillary Service Capacity Monitor Display
 - SCR786: Retail Market Test Environment
- Majority of the R5 changes are for the following functional areas:
 - Energy Management System, Enterprise Information Services, Enterprise Integration, Market Information System, Market Management System, Net Dependable Capability and Reactive Capability, Outage Scheduler



Hardware Upgrades


 Refreshed more than 20 percent of data center computer hardware (as part of DC4 initiative)

Configuration Management

 Implemented a new Configuration Management System to tightly control more than 3 million computer/software items that run ERCOT systems

Resiliency Improvements

 Deployed a second high-speed fiber network path between data centers





Governance, Risk & Compliance (GRC)

- Completed 18-month effort to create and map a full inventory of owners and procedures used to comply with Protocol requirements
- Established individual owner for each of ~4,400 "Must, Shall, or Will" requirements in the Protocols and documented business procedures and controls to ensure compliance
- AlertEnterprise tool provides singular tracking mechanism for all ERCOT requirements (Protocols, NERC standards and internal controls); updates continue as standards, owners and business processes change.
 - Advances ERCOT's Culture of Compliance
 - Provides useful tool for employees
 - Facilitates efficient audit performance
