<u>Issue:</u>

Ratification of new Officers of Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT) for 2019.

Background/History:

Since the posting of the October 2019 ERCOT Human Resources and Governance (HR&G) Committee and Board of Directors (Board) meeting agendas, ERCOT announced several executive leadership changes, including two new Officer promotions. Mara Spak has been promoted to Vice President, Human Resources, and Sean Taylor has been promoted to and assumed the position of Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, given Michael Petterson's upcoming retirement.

Section 8.2 of ERCOT's Amended and Restated Bylaws, as approved on January 17, 2019 (Bylaws), requires that the Board ratify ERCOT Officers for terms not to exceed one year. Section 8.2 further provides that Officers may be re-elected or re-ratified for consecutive terms without limitation and that all Officers shall hold office until their successors are chosen and qualified or until their earlier resignation or removal.

At its meeting on October 7, 2019, the HR&G Committee is expected to consider the ratification of the following Officers, while employed for a term not to exceed one year, as recommended by Bill Magness, President and CEO:

- Mara Spak, Vice President, Human Resources, effective October 1, 2019; and
- Sean Taylor, Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, effective October 1, 2019.

Key Factors Influencing Issue:

The Bylaws require the ratification of officers at least annually. It is preferable to ratify officers as the CEO promotes or hires executives for certain leadership roles.

Conclusion/Recommendation:

The HR&G Committee is expected to consider recommending whether the ERCOT Board should ratify the following new ERCOT officers for 2019, as recommended by



Mr. Magness, ERCOT President and CEO, while employed for a term not to exceed one year:

- Mara Spak, Vice President, Human Resources, effective October 1, 2019; and
- Sean Taylor, Vice President and Chief Financial Officer, effective October 1, 2019.
