Revisions to TAC Procedures



Revisions to TAC Procedures

On 5/29/20, TAC unanimously voted via email to approve revisions to the TAC Procedures to allow for voting at remote meetings for TAC and TAC Subcommittees under extenuating circumstances.

The revised TAC Procedures, effective June 1, 2020, allows the ERCOT General Counsel, after consulting with the TAC Chair and Vice Chair, to declare that remote voting is permitted for TAC and TAC Subcommittees.

A Market Notice was issued on June 1, 2020 making this declaration for the foreseeable future.

TAC and TAC Subcommittees are able to hold formal meetings and vote remotely, avoiding post-meeting email votes.
