Background

- Data fields included in RRGRR023, but not yet available in RIOO, are needed to properly model batteries, and Self-Limiting Facilities and DC-coupled Resources that include batteries in economic planning studies
- Data fields included in RRGRR023 are also needed to determine the capacity contribution of batteries, and Self-Limiting Facilities and DC-coupled Resources that include batteries for resource adequacy studies
- ERCOT proposed using requests for information to gather the information needed for economic planning studies in presentations provided to RPG and PLWG in May and June of 2020
- Discussions on the capacity contribution of batteries are ongoing at SAWG





- ERCOT does not have information on roundtrip efficiency, energy capacity MWh or if a battery is a part of Self-Limiting Facility (NPRR1026) or DC-Coupled Resource (NPRR1029)
- Until RRGRR023 is implemented in RIOO, ERCOT plans to collect this information via RFI
