

GTC Exit Alternatives Overview

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Protocol 3.10.7.6 (7) (Approved NPRR809)

No later than 180 days after the effective date of a new GTC, ERCOT shall post a report listing alternatives for exiting the GTC to the MIS Secure Area. The listed alternatives may include but are not limited to the implementation or modification of a RAS or a transmission improvement project.

- Exit alternatives provide an indication of the scope and scale of projects necessary to exit a GTC and should serve as a reference for consideration of transmission upgrades
- Implementation of exit alternatives is subject to the existing planning criteria



ERCOT Process

- Develop alternative that would allow GTC to be retired
- Review alternative with TSP(s)
- Report exit alternative within the GTC methodology document posted on MIS
- GTC alternatives can be considered as potential economic-driven projects in ERCOT planning processes
