# **ERCOT RIOO Interconnection Services Release Notes**

#### December, 2021

ERCOT has released a new version of Resource Integration and Ongoing Operations - Interconnection Services (RIOO - IS) that enables companies to propose a new electricity generation resource to interconnect to the Texas power grid that ERCOT manages.

Representing the company, an Interconnecting Entity (IE) or Resource Entity (RE) uses the RIOO - IS app to create and manage the generation interconnection request (INR) online. After the IE/RE submits their INR, the ERCOT Integration Team along with the Transmission or Distribution Service Provider who owns the power lines in the area, reviews the INR and conducts studies to understand the effect the generation resource may have on the grid and determine the economic feasibility of the project.

## **Updates Since Last Release**

- The Interconnection Request List dashboard page has been updated for better readability.
- In addition to IEs creating INRs, REs can now also create and work with INRs.

## **About this Guide**

This guide provides step-by-step instructions that enable REs to sign up for a RIOO Services user account for creating and working INRs, which includes getting the proper role added to their existing market profile account, providing providing the required personal information and enrolling a cell phone in a multifactor authentication (MFA) app that ERCOT requires for third-party login security.

# **Understanding the RIOO Account Sign-Up Process**

ERCOT has already set up a RIOO Services account for you using your email address from your Market Participant Identity Management (MPIM) profile as your account user name and assigning a temporary password.



 $rac{1}{2}$  It is important that this is a valid email address (not an alias) so you receive the appropriate verification and confirmation emails from the RIOO Services app.

You must contact the **User Security Administrator** (**USA**) at your company to go to your MPIM profile to assign the the appropriate GINR role that allows your access to the RIOO app.

After verifying the information through email, you can access RIOO Services, enter your user name and request to change the preassigned password.

Finally, you must enroll your cell phone in a multifactor authentication (MFA) app that verifies your login attempts. ERCOT suggests three different options for this MFA:

- Auth0 Guardian, a free app that you can download to your cell phone (from the App Store or Google Play). During sign up, you hold your phone up to your computer and scan a bar code that the MFA uses to associate your login request with the RIOO system. Each time you attempt to log in with the RIOO - IS login credentials (the email address as your user name and a password that you created), Auth0 Guardian pushes a new message to your cell phone to have you verify that you have made the login request.
- Google Authenticator, another free app that you can download to your cell phone (from the App Store or Google Play). During sign up, you hold your phone up to your computer and scan a bar code that the MFA uses to associate your login request with the RIOO system. Each time you attempt to log in with your RIOO - IS login credentials (the email address as your user name and a password that you created). Google Authenticator pushes a new 6-digit verification code that you must enter into the code verification page to authenticate your login request.
- SMS Text Authentication, a less secure method that uses a text message-enabled cell phone - not necessarily a smartphone. During sign up, you are asked to submit your cell phone number. Each time you attempt to log in with with your RIOO – IS login credentials (the email address as your user name and a password that you created), the SMS security system sends a 6-digit verification code that you must enter into the code verification page to authenticate your login request.

Or, if you have an authentication program already on your cell phone, you most likely can use that app to register and log in to Interconnection Services.


# **Before You Begin**

- Download the **AUTHO Guardian** or **Google Authenticator** MFA app from either the Apple Store or Google Play to your cell phone. If you wait to do it during the signup process, Interconnection Services may time out and display the *LogIn/SignUp* page for you to start your sign up over again.
- Have your email account open to your Inbox so you can open the email message sent to verify your account.
- Have a text editor (such as Notepad or Word) file open that you named something like
  RIOO Services Recovery Code so you can easily copy in your recovery code as
  recommended when you work through this process. The recovery code can help you log in to
  your account if you do not have your cell phone handy.


# **Asking Your USA to Modify Your MPIM Profile**

You must have the GINR\_M\_Operator role in your Market Participant Identity Management (MPIM) profile to access and use RIOO Interconnection Services.




# **Verifying Your Account from the Welcome Email**

After your USA confirms that your profile, smartphone number, and email address are accessible and has given you the appropriate RIOO role, it may take up to **15-20 minutes** to get an email from ercot.com to verify your account.




You can set up Auth0 Guardian, Google Authenticator, or the SMS Messaging as the MFA.
