



ERCOT GTC Updates

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A New Hamilton GTC

- 2022 Q3 QSA identified the stability constraints due to a new Generation Resource connected to 69-kV grid at Hamilton county.
- A follow up GTC study confirmed the need to establish the Hamilton GTC to address the stability constraints under N-1-1 conditions. No stability constraints when there are no prior outages in the area.
- This GTC is not IROL.
- This GTC became effective on August 3, 2022. This GTC interface and associated Generic Transmission Limit (GTLs) are available in the posted Generic Transmission Constraints Methodology.
