

LLI Queue – Trends Since April 2022




Changes since September LFLTF meeting

- Some projects cancelled
- New load interconnection requests received
- One duplicate project identified and removed from the queue



Current Load Requests by Connection Type



Current LLI Interconnection Queue



- In Service Includes projects that are currently in operation or that have received approval to energize from ERCOT Operations.
- Met Planning Projects that have received approval of the required planning studies and are expected to receive approval to energize by the
 requested in-service date.
- **Deferred –** Project MWs that were limited after ERCOT review or for which the project owner has provided an energization schedule.
- In Study Projects that have studies under review by ERCOT
- Planned Projects that are tracked by ERCOT but that have not yet provided sufficient information to begin review.



LLI Interconnection Queue - Comments

- The methodology for this chart follows what was presented at the September LFLTF meeting except "In Service" has been split into "Operational" and "Met Planning."
- This chart accounts for
 - Staged energization schedules
 - MWs limited by the interim process that have a defined exit strategy
- The 2027 column include projects with no in-service date currently defined and deferred MWs with no clear path to approval
