**Key Takeaway:** Continued focus on tech health as well as business deliverables while delivering major projects like EMS upgrade.



# **EMS Upgrade**

- Communications with Market Participants via Inter-Control Center Protocol (ICCP) already cutover on both sites
  - This was the first step in the sequence for closed loop testing
- Closed loop testing on October 12, 2023
  - 4-hour test duration with MPs
  - Analyze results for Go-No Go decision
- Go-Live is scheduled for November 16, 2023

Key Takeaway: EMS upgrade project continues to be ahead of schedule and under budget



# **Cloud Computing Pilot**

#### Problem

 Need to run a large number (~100K) of simulations within two weeks to support Reliability Standard deliverable

#### Options

- Get more desktop machines not possible in time frame
- Commission many servers on-prem time and capacity constraints
- Use temporary compute in cloud chosen option

#### Outcome

- Using a cloud solution, leveraged 8000 cores and parallelized the computation. Simulations ran in less than a day
- Met the deadline for the PUCT submission

**Key Takeaway:** Delivered our first ever Infrastructure as a Service (laaS) project in record time that provided a huge value to business.

#### **Other IT Initiatives**

#### Annual ERCOT Membership process automation

- Automated a process that typically takes a month for legal person to collect all the Membership documents
- Used a simplified automated workflow in the Service Management system

#### Ongoing improvements with Public Service Portal

- Go live was 4/6/2023
- Total number of Users Registered = 1,069
- Total number of Cases Created = 1,207
- Total number of Cases Resolved = 1,105
- Average Resolution time = 7 days

Key Takeaway: Continuing to focus on process optimization and digitalization.
