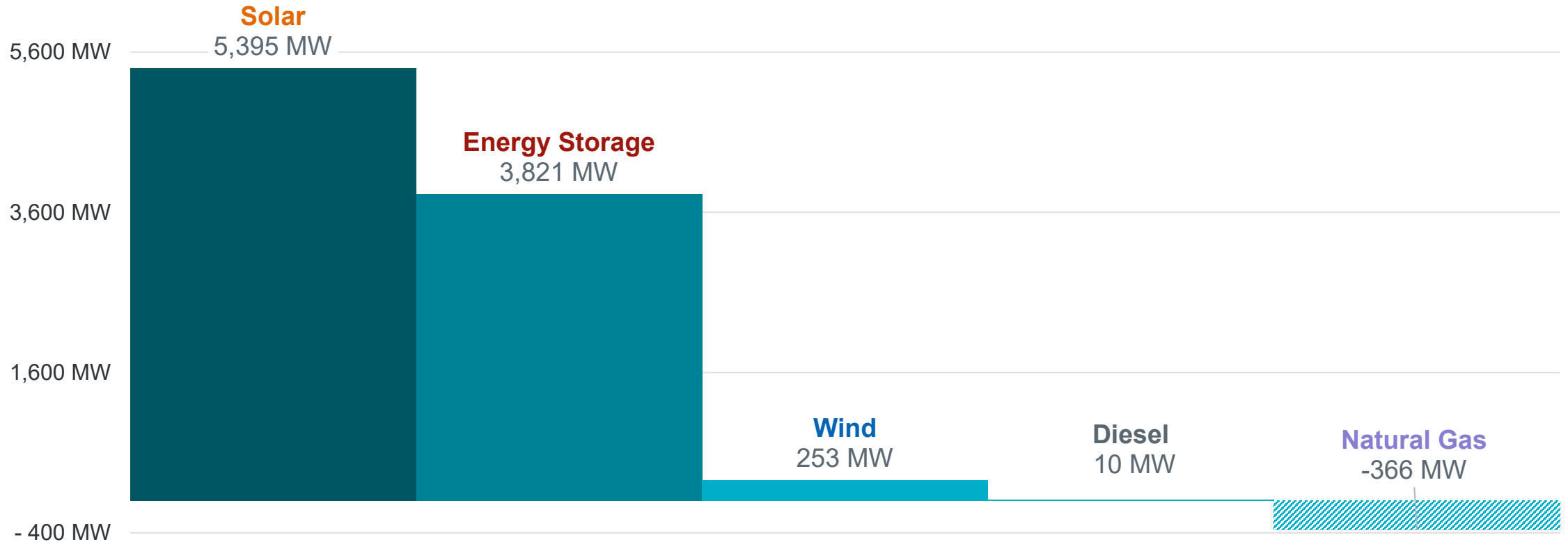

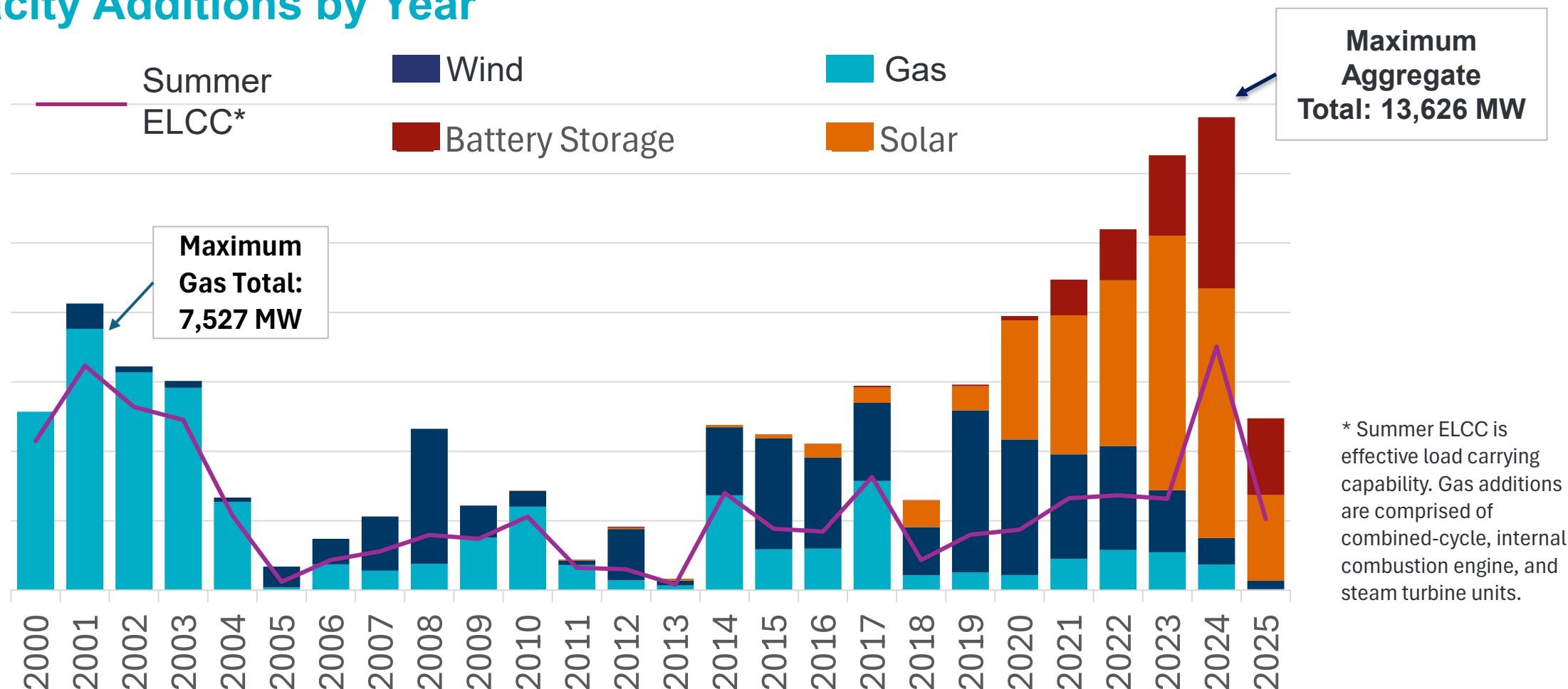
- The ERCOT grid has seen the addition of more than 9,600 MW of capacity since last summer, but a net loss of natural gas.
- ERCOT has taken steps to fortify the grid in the San Antonio area, securing 15 mobile generation units.
- The 89th legislative session has come to a close, marking the end of this year's policymaking period.

## Capacity Additions Since Last Summer (October 1, 2024 – May 31, 2025)



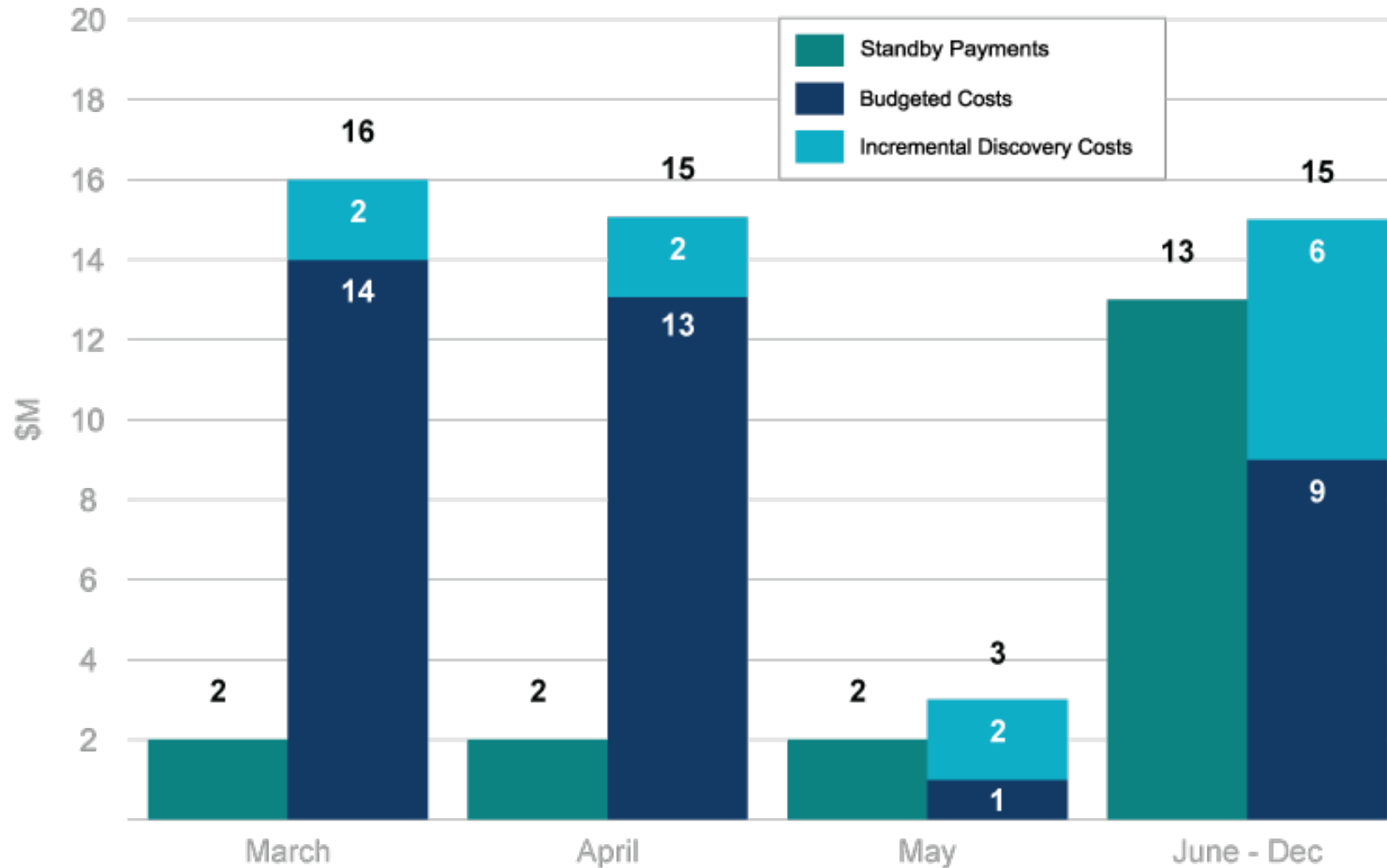
**Key Takeaway:** While the ERCOT grid has seen the addition of 9,645 MW of new capacity since summer 2024, natural gas has a net loss of 366 MW due to retirements, derates, and indefinite mothballs. Energy storage resources will play an important role this summer as solar generation ramps down each night.

# Capacity Additions by Year



**Key Takeaway:** The Effective Load Carrying Capability (ELCC) is an effective view of generation's ability to serve demand. The capacity additions in 2024 were 65% higher than 2021, but the 2024 ELCC was only slightly higher than 2001, reflecting the large proportion of gas resources in that year.

## Braunig Unit 3 Reliability Must-Run (RMR) Costs (2025 Only)



**Key Takeaway:** The total cost for committing Braunig Unit 3 for RMR service has increased by about \$12 million since the RMR Agreement was executed in early December. Current RMR settlement processes do not allow RMR costs to be reimbursed when they are incurred. ERCOT intends to propose an NPRR to allow more timely recovery of these costs.

# Life Cycle Power Mobile Generation Solution Update

- On June 4, ERCOT executed an Emergency Generation Service Agreement with Life Cycle Power (LCP) providing for the transfer of 15 mobile generators (~450 MW total nameplate) from Houston to San Antonio and the interconnection and operation of the generators at 9 CPS Energy substations.
- CenterPoint has allowed ERCOT to use the generators until as late as March 31, 2027, or until they are no longer needed.
- The agreement required significant cooperation and effort from CPS Energy and CenterPoint, including developing many new contracts.
- The agreement requires LCP to move the generators to San Antonio at pace of 5 generators every 31 days, with first generators operating by July 4, 2025.
- Life Cycle Power has already begun to move generators. All generators will be modeled on July 1, 2025.



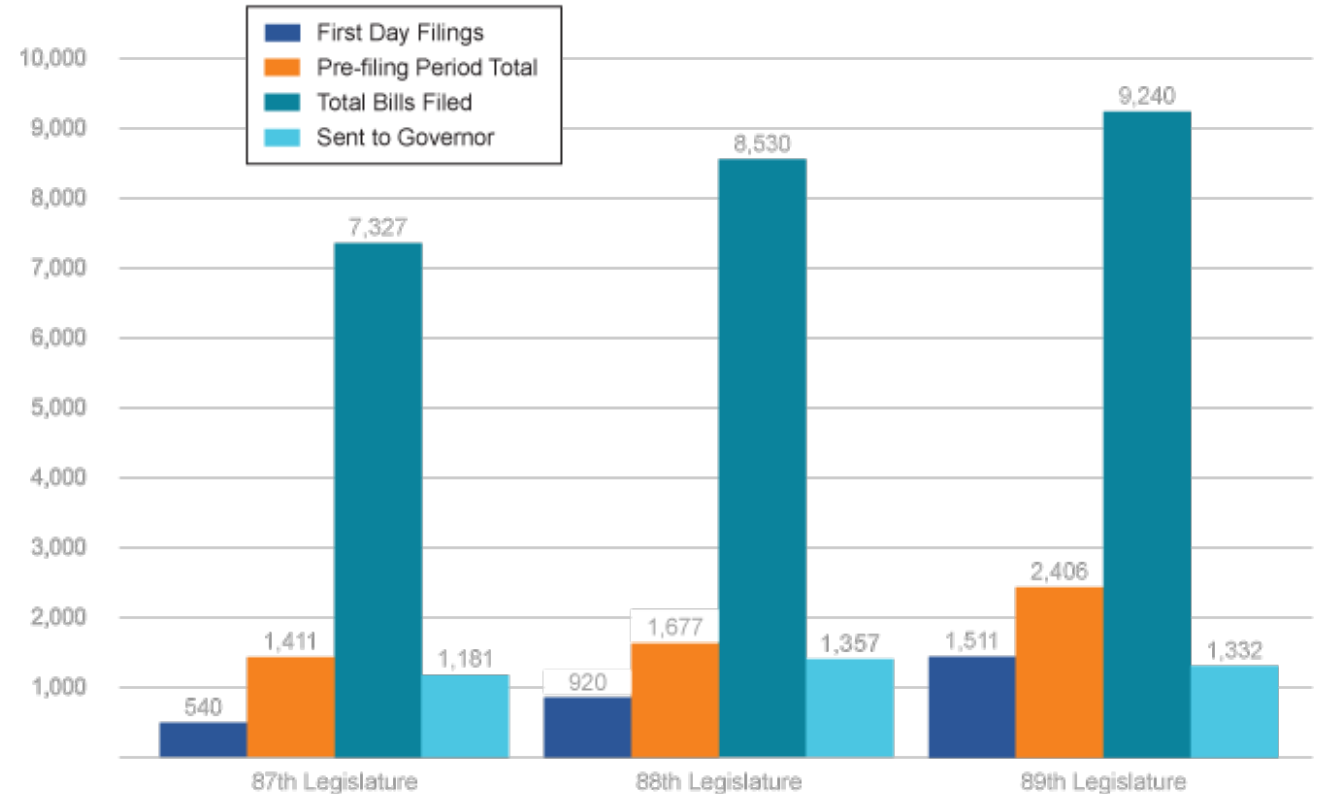

**Key Takeaway:** ERCOT, LCP, CPS Energy, and CenterPoint have finalized the contractual framework needed to move the LCP mobile generators to San Antonio and commence operations starting in early July.

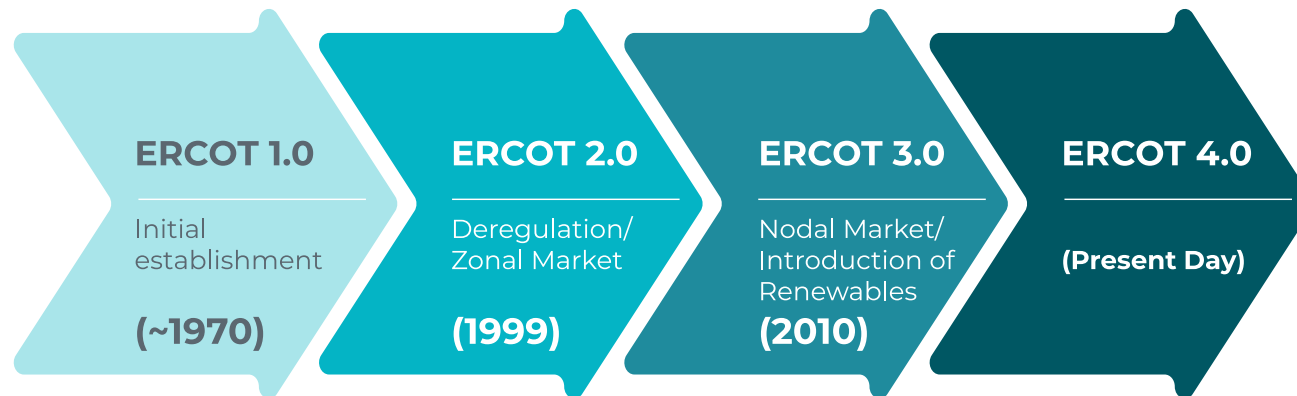

Bill Filing and Passage Trends in Regular Legislative Sessions

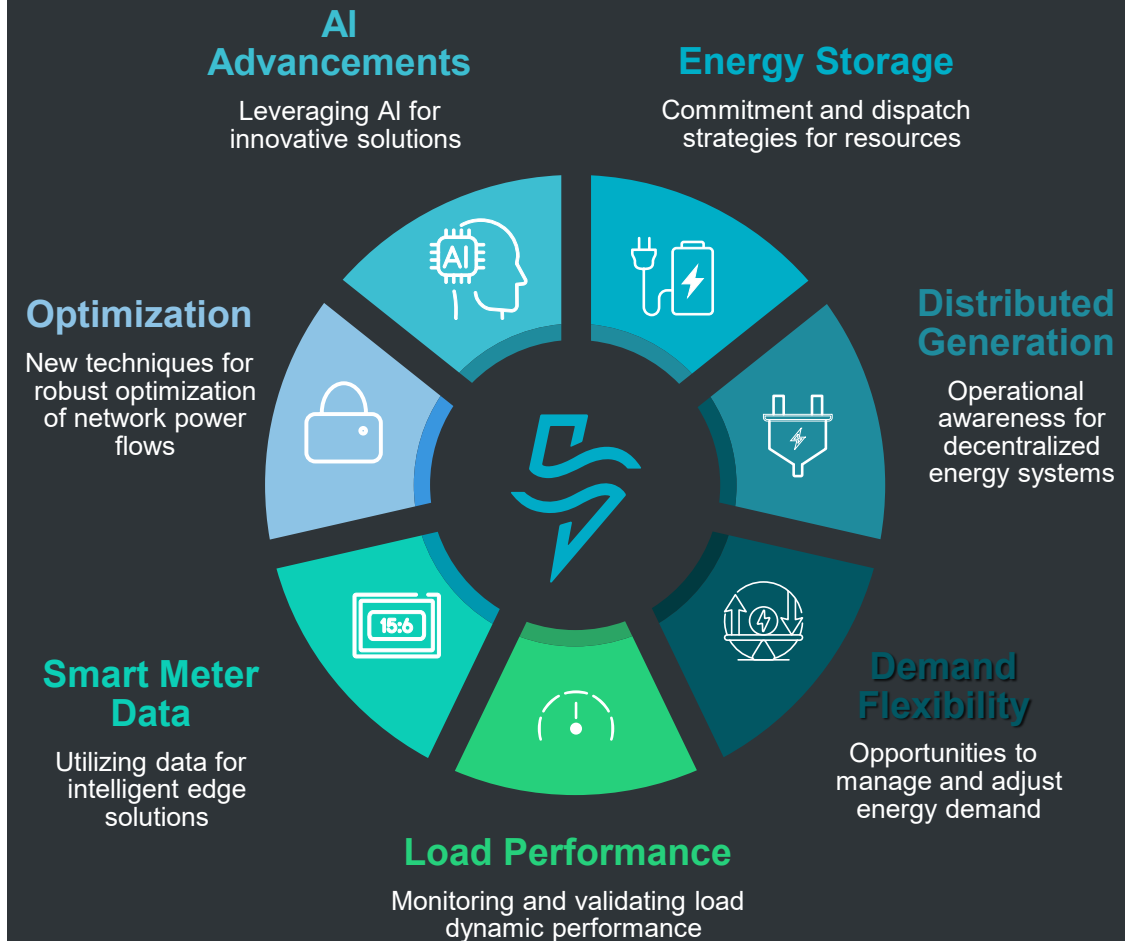
