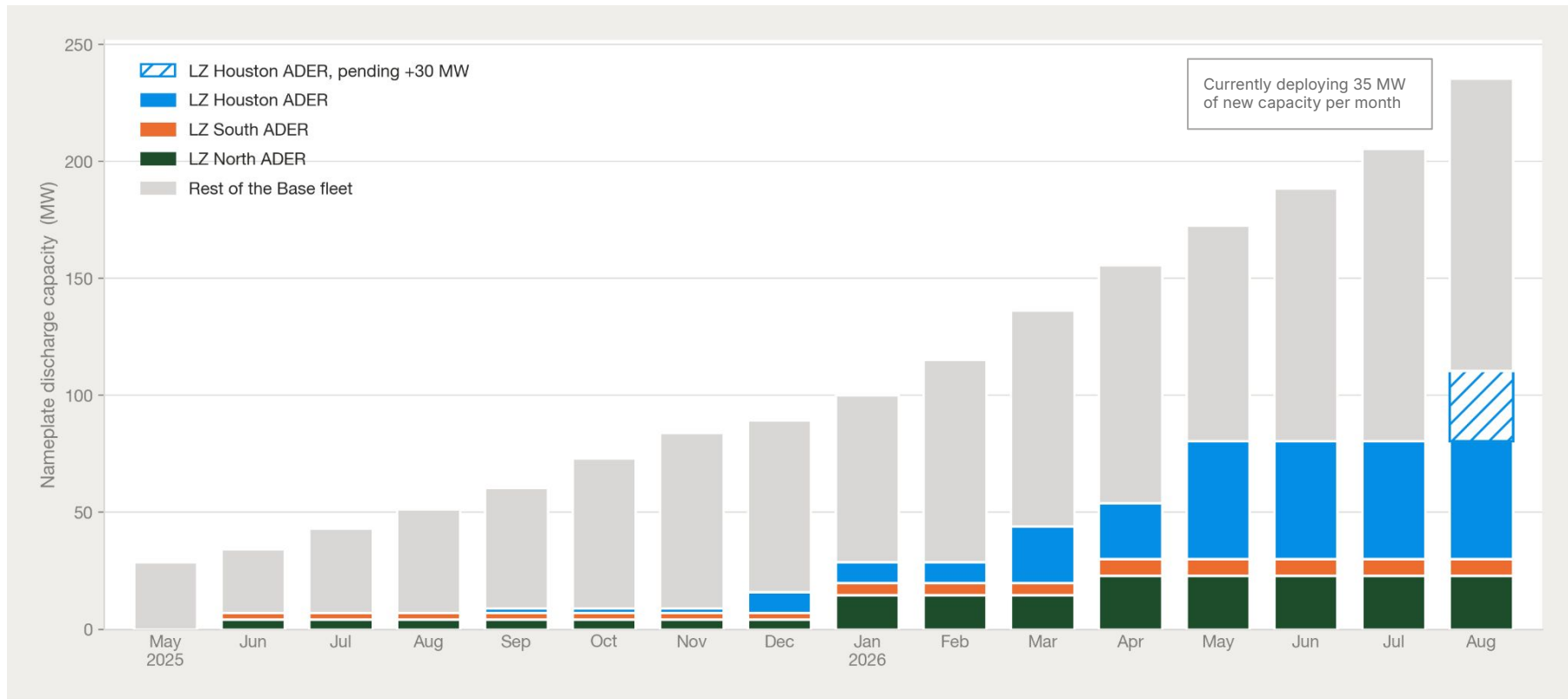

Commentary

- ERCOT's proposal for an ADER Pilot Phase IV is a critical first step in recognizing the locational value of DER aggregations on the transmission system
- Clear pathway forward in the coming months to address key issues (registration, metering, settlement) raised in the [April DSWG ADER progress summary](#), but agree that nodal resource formation and nodal dispatch are the critical path issue
- Base Power continuing to increase aggregation volumes as fast as current approval pipelines permit; additional capacity growth outpaces resource volume extension approval process, installing today at a rate of **35 MW per month** and growing
- A total of **250 MW** of Base Power's fleet brought online over last year alone, **100 MW** approved for participation in ADER across LZ Houston, North and South with upcoming PLD
- Existing fleets continue to participate in SCED 24/7, offering energy and reserves, while actively maintaining UDSP tolerances expected of utility-scale resources.
